OUR MISSION: Freedom13, founded on February 2, 2015, is on a mission to rebuild dignity in the lives of those we serve. Our theme verse (and why the number 13) is Galatians 5:13, which says "For you were called to freedom brothers. Only do not use your freedom as an opportunity for the flesh, but through love, serve one another."

Freedom13 serves the community through Jail Ministry ("Hope Restored") in Lincoln and Ouachita Parishes. They offer workshops for students and parents, emphasizing the reality of technology, social media, and the impact of smartphones have on mental health ("Hope Forward"). They also offer recovery resources and local connections for women who need a fresh start in life ("Hope Connection"). Regular outreach events include Prayer Walks, A Queen's Celebration, and Called to Freedom.

CURRENT NEEDS:
