What is the Annie Armstrong Easter Offering?

The offering was started in 1895 by Woman's Missionary Union® (WMU) to benefit the work of the Home Mission Board (now North American Mission Board). In 1934, it was named in honor of Annie Armstrong, a bold missions advocate and WMU's first national executive leader. Today, more than \$2 billion has been donated by Southern Baptist churches and individuals to support thousands of missionaries in church planting and compassion ministries. Because of this sacrificial giving, millions of lives have been and continue to be transformed by the power of the gospel.

PASTOR'S CORNER.....

Psalm 55:22 says, Cast your burden on the Lord, and He shall sustain you; He shall never permit the righteous to be moved.

To cast means to throw off or hurl down, but the word burden here means to have what is appointed or given or allowed. How do you cast off something that God has allowed you to carry? The key is in the word sustain, "And He shall sustain you." It means that God will contain down to the smallest measurement what you can bear.

Matt 6:34 "Therefore do not worry about tomorrow, for tomorrow will worry about its own things. Sufficient for the day is its own trouble." In other words, cast your burdens before Jesus for today and He will sustain you. Tomorrow do the same, and the next, and the next. Why? So that we learn as David says, "Lord I trust in You."
